WHEREAS, one in three young people are affected by physical, sexual or verbal dating violence, with one in five who are in a serious relationship reporting having been assaulted, threatened or coerced by a partner; and

WHEREAS, young people can make better decisions when they understand that healthy relationships are based on respect and when they learn to identify early warning signs of an abusive relationship; and

WHEREAS, elimination of dating violence must be achieved through the cooperative efforts of individuals, organizations and communities; and


